When CenMASC offers multiple events on one scheduled weekend, **UNDERDOG Awards** will be given to qualifying phenomenal canines. Dogs must be Australian Shepherds of any size. Registration is not required, rescue dogs welcome. The **UNDERDOG** must "qualify" in 2 or more events on the same weekend.

PRIZES

Obedience: Ribbons and prizes will be awarded for class placements and qualifying scores.

Conformation: Ribbons and prizes will be awarded for class placements; Rosettes for breed wins.

There will be ample crating space in the ring adjacent to the show ring. Room will be available for grooming tables and chairs as well. There are very limited electrical outlets and blow drying is not encouraged. Please bring mats or rugs to place under crates to protect the mats. Please pick up after your dogs, and keep the building in great shape.

- To educate members, enthusiasts and the general public through all available venues whenever possible.
